Carol Price moved into Olton Grange in April 2024, beginning her journey into supported living with quiet determination. At 57 years old and living with Parkinson’s Disease, depression, and epilepsy, the adjustment brought challenges, but also possibilities.

Initially, Carol was hesitant to engage with others. Kind, soft-spoken, and reserved, she preferred to keep to herself, avoiding communal spaces and social activities. She didn’t want to be a burden to anyone. But with time, patience, and compassionate support from the Olton Grange team, Carol slowly began to open up.

As trust grew, so did her confidence. She started to enjoy conversations with staff, share stories from her life, and take part in activities. Meaningful connections then followed.

Staff worked alongside Carol to identify goals that mattered most to her:

- ✓ Settling into Olton Grange.
- ✓ Re-engaging with the wider community.
- ✓ Rebuilding confidence in social settings.
- ✓ Managing her own medication.
- ✓ Attending appointments.

GROWTH AND ACHIEVEMENT

Carol’s progress over the months has been remarkable. With the right encouragement and support structures in place, she developed the confidence to get out into the community; navigating public transport, attending appointments independently, visiting family and friends, and going to church. Her strong Christian faith was a personal anchor throughout, giving her daily motivation and a positive mindset in her pursuit of better mental health and stability.

Among her greatest achievements has been a newfound sense of independence; something she worked hard for, and which the team at Olton Grange was proud to support her in achieving.
