IN THE EARLY DAYS

Sharon is 67 years old and came to Radcliffe House following a referral from Asket House, Leeds and York Partnership NHS Foundation Trust in April 2021. Sharon lives with Paranoid Schizophrenia, and as one of the first residents to join Radcliffe House, was a little unsure at first. Over time Sharon has settled into the service, she now engages with residents and the team. She has a particularly close bond with the two fellow residents who joined Radcliffe House on day one with her.

CELEBRATING EACH STEP

Sharon is very content at Radcliffe House and her confidence and independence have improved:

- Sharon has a self-contained flat.
- ✓ Sharon's care team have stepped back. They feel Sharon is settled and does not require their input.

- ▼ Sharon no longer has a named Social Worker as she is doing so well.
- ✓ Sharon is no longer on a Community

 Treatment Order.

The team are delighted with her progress. Sharon engages with occupational therapy when she chooses including baking and arts and crafts. She expresses that she is happy, she loves music, knitting for the premature baby unit and visiting the local charity shops. She also hopes to get married one day.
