We are incredibly proud of his hard work and dedication to supporting our environment. The team at Milnshaw House can't wait to see all he achieves in this inspiring role!


A Milestone in Learning and Personal Growth

SUPPORTING NHS TRUSTS DURING WINTER PRESSURES: OPTIMISING PATIENT PATHWAYS.

Northern Healthcare offers adult supported living placements across the North West, Cumbria, Yorkshire, and the Midlands, providing vital assistance to NHS Trusts during the winter months when hospital bed demand exceeds capacity. Many individuals face delayed discharges or struggle to access the care and support they need due to limited community services.

With our extensive experience working closely with NHS Trusts, Integrated Care Boards and Local Authorities we help alleviate winter bed pressures by optimising patient pathways and ensuring the efficient use of supported living resources. Creating integrated care pathways is key to supporting individuals in their recovery journey, and we are committed to working with the NHS to reduce hospital admissions, shorten inpatient stays, expedite discharges, and minimize the need for out-of-area placements.

Our services not only provide long-term cost savings to the NHS but also ensure individuals have a safe and supportive environment as they transition back to independent living.

How Northern Healthcare Can Assist with Winter Pressures:

- √ 12-week discharge-to-assess pathways (available as individual or block contracts)
- ✓ Hospital avoidance pathways for individuals needing short-term or crisis intervention
- ✓ 24/7 community rehabilitation services for longterm mental health care

The success of our past winter pressure initiatives has enabled us to support individuals in successfully transitioning to independent living, finding suitable placements with other providers, or, when needed, continuing their journey with Northern Healthcare for ongoing support.
